






"A New Option"

For green 6-sided dice, any number of players, on any number of instruments.

Instructions:

Every player must have a green die. Each player assigns an instruction to each number on the die in the space provided below. Players cannot discuss their instructions prior to playing. One die number must have the instruction "END" assigned to it. When this is thrown, the player must cease playing for the remainder of the performance. At least one number must be assigned an instruction which is truly uncomfortable (see notes). All other numbered instructions can determine pitch, timbre, duration, technique, melodic approach or any other musical concept the player desires. The dice must be thrown at least once per performance. The performance ends when all players have ceased playing. However, each instruction must be adhered to: players may not immediately rethrow their dice. They must obey the dice.

Notes:

Uncomfortable instructions are highly individual. They may be as simple as "sit in silence" or "play obnoxiously", or as theatrical/confronting as "tell a joke through your instrument" or "figure out that pop song you hate". These instructions do ~~not~~ have to be torturous, and cannot be dangerous.
